Executive Briefings/Admin Update

Administrative Update by Alan Lavizzo

- 1. 2019-2020
 - ullet Department budgets, enrollment and staffing projections come in around February 22^{nd} . Once those numbers are available, administration can then finalize the Master Schedule for next year.
 - Admin is projecting a loss of 2 FTE. We can expect an increase in the student : teacher ratio.
 - Conversations were had about the effect of School of Choice on our enrollment and budget.
- 2. Spring Event
 - May 10th is the final, admin approved date.
 - Fliers going out to the community next week
 - Karri Haugsness recommended a "Save the Date" go out to the community by March 1st.
 - Karri Haugsness recommended dinner for the event be figured out soon and volunteered to coordinate dinner.
- 3. AIM, Honors, AVID Meeting
 - Most of the comment/questions cards showed excitement for and interest in, the AVID program. The second most noted comment was about how AIM class size would be affected by the changes.
- 4. Students are beginning to register for the 19-20 school year.

Treasurer's Report by Hope Neal

- A review of the current P&L led into a conversation around NEST Grants. See those notes under "Old Business".
- Spending from within the budget was approved by the board to purchase more metal stakes for the Spirit Night signs

Old Business

1. Grant Update

- Spring Grant session will open Thursday 3/1 and close 3/15. The Board is expecting to have around \$8000 in Grant funds. PTCO Grant Meeting is scheduled for Thursday 3/28 from 3-5pm.
 - o Issues around subscriptions will have been addressed internally by then.
- Many teachers found lower cost options and came in under budget by approximately \$903. The school's budget paid for those that spent more than what was allocated to them. The Board would like to reimburse the school's budget for the cost of the "overages". A Motion to "refund" the school's budget for a total of \$147 was brought by Steve Clerkin and seconded by Jennifer Ryan.
- PBIS budget item Admin requested a change in how the funds that were granted for this purpose are used. Motion to Approve a change in what the PBIS funds will be purchasing was brought by Sarah Otto and seconded by Hope Neal.
- Conversations around monies yet to be spent were had around the table.

2. 2019-2020 Board Positions

- Required training for President and Treasurer offered May 6th @ the Fremont Building.
- Fall Fundraiser still in need of 2 people to co-chair the event.
- All nominations will be posted for 30 days and voted upon in April.
